



## Technical Meeting – Answers to Written Questions

31<sup>st</sup> July 2019

NPC Great Britain	
Question	Will all horizontal jumpers receive six jumps?
Answer	<b>Yes, all athletes in horizontal jumps receive six jumps. There will be no reversal after the 3<sup>rd</sup> round.</b>
Question	In an emergency, can our own doctor and/or physiotherapist get access to the track?
Answer	<b>No, there will be official medical staff appointed by the LOC.</b>  <b>Medical treatment by accredited team medical can be administered in the designated area (Medical tent).</b>  <b>Please refer to Rule 7.1</b>
Question	Where will classification notices be posted?
Answer	<b>Classification outcomes «after observation assessment» will be posted at the wall in the Sports Arena (start list / result board).</b>
Question	If there is a delay in call room (e.g. 20 minutes or more) will day chairs be allowed within the call room?
Answer	<b>No. Athletes in wheelchair track events may not enter the call room in their day chairs.</b>
Question	Are there any rollers available for wheelchair racing warm up?
Answer	<b>No, the LOC doesn't offer rollers for warm up.</b>

<b>NPC Spain</b>	
Question	Request to separate the timetable classes 11 and 12 from class 13, U17 and U20, male and female, long jump. Considering the precedent of the year 2017, that was not separate and the athletes stayed waiting in call room too much time.
<b>Answer</b>	<b>No, there is no possibility to change the schedule at this late stage.</b>
Question	Request to announce in each long jump, shot put, javelin and discus throw, U17 and U20, male and female, the mark and the Raza Points.
<b>Answer</b>	<b>No. Raza Points can only be calculated at the end of the event.</b>
